It takes a whole range of people from all backgrounds to provide public services in the UK. If the BNP had their way, they'd take vital workers right out of the picture, leaving our public services to grind to a halt.

The BNP believes the only Britons are those who are white, and that white Britons should be given priority for jobs. This goes against UNISON values as it makes everyone else a second-class citizen.

If the BNP's racist policies were implemented our NHS would collapse because:

- 38% of hospital doctors in England qualified outside Britain
- 40% of dentists were born abroad
- 16% of nurses come from Black and Asian backgrounds, while 44,000 overseas-trained nurses work in the NHS.

The BNP argues that Black and migrant workers – many of whom are UNISON members – are taking jobs from white Britons. In the real world our Black and migrant members are essential people doing essential jobs.

The fight against the BNP is also a fight for public services.

UNISON represents everybody – the BNP does not. We campaign year round to defend a dynamic and inclusive multicultural society, one that values all its members equally, irrespective of their race, nationality, gender, sexual orientation or disability.
