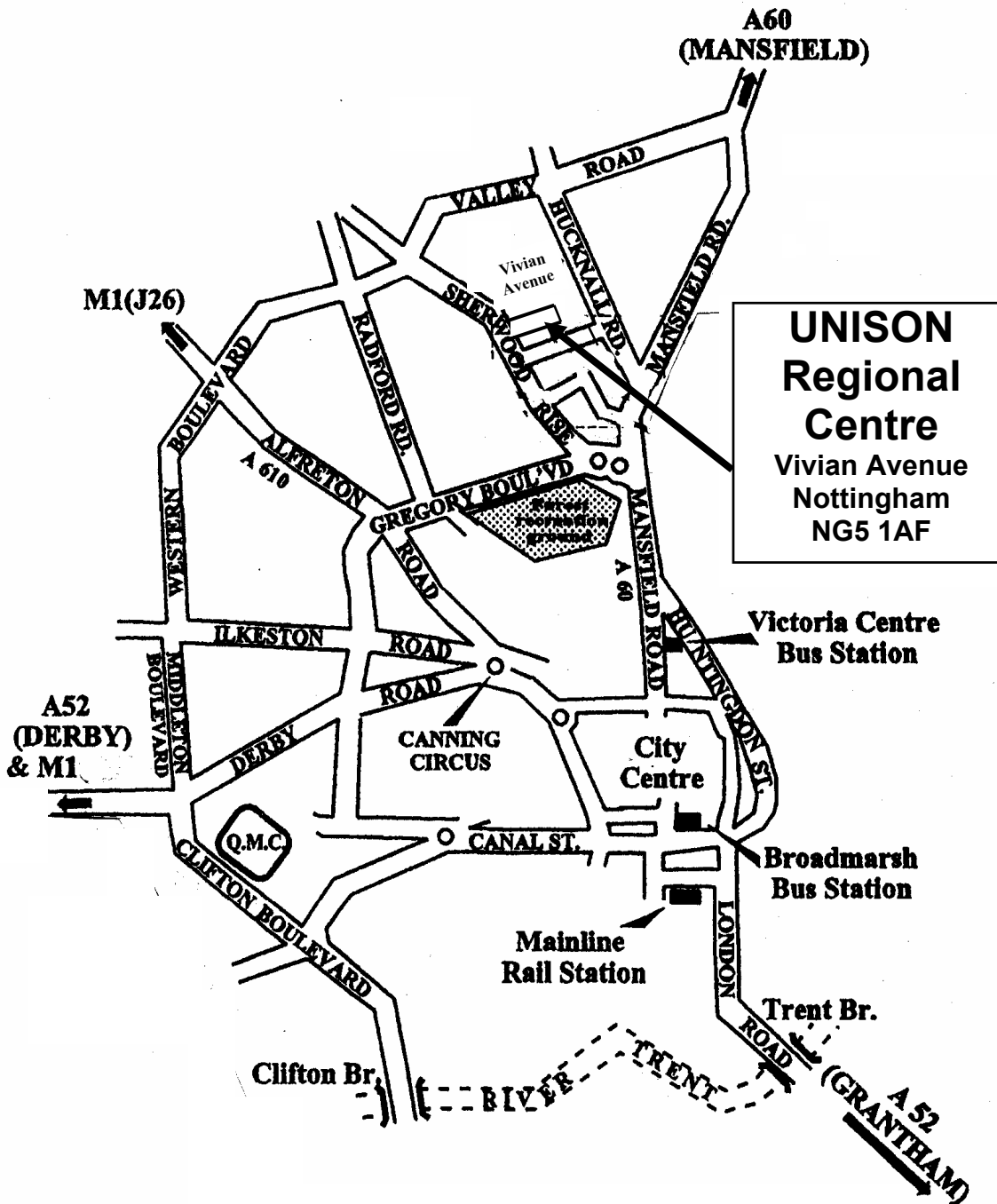
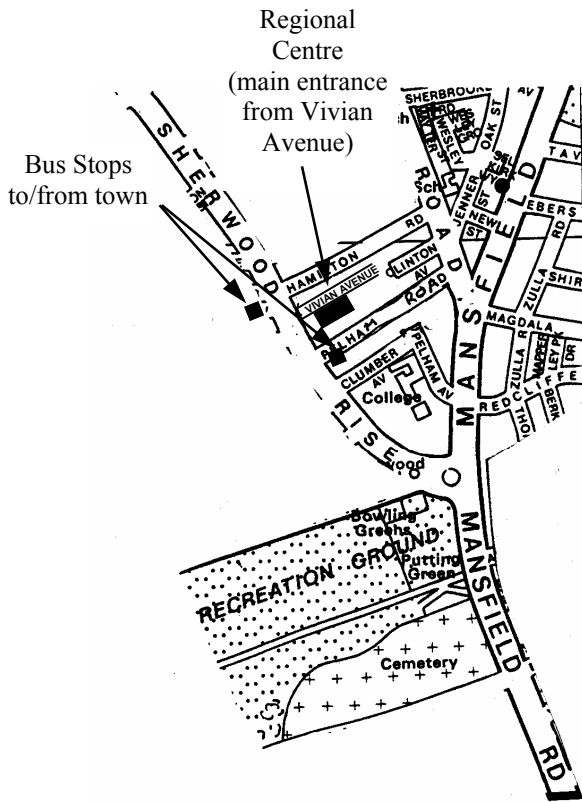




Travelling to the UNISON Regional Centre

Buses from Nottingham City Centre

Buses serving the Sherwood Rise area all depart from Milton Street. The easiest service to use to the Regional Centre is the NCT **Yellow Line Service**. All of the services marked Yellow Line—the **68, 69, 70, 71 and 72**— use the same route along Sherwood Rise, where the Regional Centre is situated. Yellow Line services have a combined 6 to 7 minute frequency (9 buses per hour) during the day and more at peak times. They leave from bus stops marked **T3** and **T4** which are on the west side of Milton Street.

Buses travel north up Mansfield Road, and go past two roundabouts then up Sherwood Rise. The nearest stop is the second one on Sherwood Rise, just after passing Vivian Avenue on the right hand side.

Fares

The easiest way to pay is to ask for a £3.00 City Rider ticket on the bus. This allows you to travel all day on NCT services and also NET tram services. The ordinary single fare Milton Street—Sherwood Rise is £1.50. A warning—NCT buses do **not** give change.

Getting to Milton Street from Nottingham Railway Station

Milton Street is about a 10 minute walk away from the Railway Station (see map on left). If you have difficulty walking, there is a bus stop on Carrington Street opposite the station (stop S5). All buses with “City Loop” on their destination blind take a circular route through the city centre, and will drop you off on Parliament Street, which is a short walk to Milton Street.

Queries

If you’re still not sure, you can ring Nottingham City Transport’s call centre on **(0115) 9 50 60 70** or call into their Travel Centre at **5 South Parade**, on the Old Market Square. NCT is the only bus company in the region still in public ownership, the majority shareholder being Nottingham City Council.
