

**ISA is
coming –

The new Independent Safeguarding Authority (ISA) vetting and barring scheme – aimed at protecting children and vulnerable adults – comes into force in July 2010.

If you work with children or vulnerable adults, or deal with sensitive information or records, you may have to register on this new scheme at a cost of between £58- £100 depending on which country you live in.
