UNISON campaigns to promote your rights at work, decent jobs, public services and the NHS.

By law, UNISON has to pay for campaigns from a separate fund. Members opt-in to the campaign fund on top of their union membership subscription, paying an additional 5% (between 7p and £1.13 a month, depending on salary).

Added up these small contributions make a huge difference. They guarantee that governments and political parties hear our case for better working conditions and understand the challenges facing public services.

The fund has two sections and you choose where your 5% contribution goes:

**UNISON Labour Link,**  
which takes our priorities  
into the Labour Party

**The Campaign Fund,**  
which works independently  
of all political parties.
