

UNISON is campaigning for a fair pay rise for school support staff in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. We have submitted a pay claim calling for a wage rise of £3,000 or 10%, whichever is higher in your individual circumstance – a flat rate increase would be pro rata'd for part time and term time only workers. A decent pay offer is essential and it's only by standing together that we will send a clear message to employers that you deserve more.
