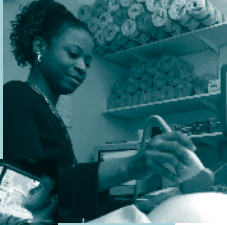

The Tory-led government's Health & Social Care Bill will lead to the break-up of the NHS and widespread privatisation. The government claims it is a patient-friendly attempt to "liberate the NHS". The reality is very different.
