POLICE STAFF PAY CONSULTATION

Vote to reject 1% pay offer



UNISON members working for police forces in England and Wales are being asked to vote to reject the employers' 1% pay offer and to move to a formal industrial action ballot, because:

- holding back on pay has not saved the 18,500 police staff jobs that have been cut since 2010
- your pay is worth 13% less now than it was in 2010
- you face on-going pay restraint lasting until at least 2017
- you do vital jobs that keep communities safe – paying you fairly is good for communities too.
