### **UNISON members in Action for Children are on strike today across the UK**

The strike is in response to management imposing a pay deal of just 1% – and it excludes two-thirds of staff.

Staff have had almost no pay increase in the last five years. Their real-terms pay has dropped 18.4%, or £4,750 for a full-time employee.

Despite this, in recent years staff and their trade unions have worked with management to deliver two huge change programmes and save £3.2million last year.

In response, last year, management unilaterally cut car mileage payments and have now removed pay increments from new staff. They added five more top jobs paying £70,000 a year, and another director on £120,000 a year.

- A 1% pay offer, but excluding two-thirds of staff.
- A real terms pay drop of £4,750
- Five new top jobs on £70,000 a year, plus a director on £120,000
- Cuts to mileage payments
- Removal of incremental pay for new staff.
