For years now public service workers have seen their pay held back by government in the name of austerity. First a freeze then a cap, resulting in public sector pay rising by just 4.4% between 2010 and 2016 while the cost of living rose by 22%.

But the tide may be turning. The government is now under real pressure to scrap the 1% cap on public sector wages and UNISON is leading the fight to get you the pay rise you deserve. And more and more people are listening and supporting our Pay Up Now! campaign.

- an end to the pay cap
- government money made available for an immediate pay rise for all public sector workers
