Nearly 9 out of 10 schools are facing

real-terms cuts.

As a result of the campaign by parents, heads, teachers and support staff, the Government has found £1.3bn over the next two years from other parts of the Department for Education's budget.

This, while welcome, is nowhere near enough to reverse the £2.8bn in cuts that schools have suffered since 2015.

And under the current plans, schools are set to lose £4bn more by 2020.
