In order to facilitate your access to the hotel, we would like to highlight that there are many car parks only a short distance from the Echo Arena.

In addition to the below information, we would like to highlight that for your convenience, all of our guests can access the hotel directly at our drop off point, which is situated in front of our hotel. This will allow you the opportunity to drop your luggage off prior to parking in one of the below car parks.

### **Kings Dock Car Park**

Conveniently located within Kings Dock providing easy access to Echo Arena, BT Convention Centre and Exhibition halls: Hotels: Albert Dock attractions: Liverpool city centre; Liverpool ONE and Museums.

There are 165 external car spaces. Payment can be made using pay and display machines or phone and pay



## Q Park Liverpool ONE



Q Park has several large city centre car parks within walking distance of the ECHO Arena (Image: Q Park)

This well-located car park off the main road along the waterfront is huge, with 1,900 spaces at 35 Strand Street, L1 8LT.

Parking costs £2.50 for up to one hour, £12.50 for up to five hours and £16 for up to 12 hours.

There are 81 disabled parking spots, two electric charging points and a maximum vehicle height of 2.1m.

## Q Park Hanover Street

This car park has more than 550 spaces, and you can access it via Gradwell Street, L1 5AQ.

It is open 24/7 and parking costs £2.50 for up to one hour, £12.50 for up to five hours and £16 for up to 12 hours.

There are three disabled parking spaces and a maximum height of 2.1m.

## **King Park**

Parkopedia says King Park has 250 spaces and is one of the closest to the ECHO Arena, based on Kings Dock Street, L1 8LE.

Parking costs £0.80 for up to one hour, or £4 for five to 12 hours.

## **Q Park John Lewis**

Another Q Park site by John Lewis has 581 parking spaces, including 28 disabled spots, on Liver Street, L1 8LJ.

It has a distinctive footbridge over Hanover Street into John Lewis, and is open 24/7.

Parking costs £2.50 for up to one hour, £12.50 for up to five hours and £16 for up to 12 hours.

## **Albert Dock**

These parking spots are some of the closest to the ECHO Arena, but space is limited and there are no more than a few hundred.

The spaces are on Gower Street and Salthouse Quay, and are available 24/7 at L3 4AS.

Staying for up to one hour costs £3, up to five hours £9.50 and up to 12 hours £15.50.
