




### Q2 What form of sexual harassment have you experienced at work? Please tick all that apply





#### Q3 How often do you experience sexual harassment at work?







#### Q5 Have you ever witnessed a colleague being sexually harassed at work?





# Q6 If you have experienced sexual harassment at work, who was the perpetrator? Please tick all boxes that apply





# Q7 If you have been sexually harassed at work, did you report it to your employer?





### Q8 If you were sexually harassed at work in the future, which of these, if any, would you consider seeking support from?





# Q9 To what extent do you agree or disagree with this statement: Nurses are better protected from sexual harassment now than they ever have been





### Q11 Do you feel like enough is being done in your workplace to protect you from sexual harassment?





#### Q13 Which of the following best describes your role?





### Q14 Which of the following best describes the setting you work in?








