

UNISON members at the Care Quality Commission have voted decisively for action over pay.

You have had a pay award imposed of between just 2.75% and 3.5%, along with a small non-consolidated payment despite the ongoing cost of living crisis - given the soaring cost of living, this represents a major pay cut.

You have endured years of pay cuts in real terms. The value of your pay is now 25% lower than it was in 2010. All CQC staff provide an essential public service supporting the safe functioning of our health and social care systems.

Our members say **Enough** is **Enough** – you deserve to be fairly paid.

It's time to get ready for action and demand fair pay for fair work at CQC – here are 3 things you can do to prepare:

1. Speak to colleagues about the issue

Talk to your colleagues about the situation with their pay and make sure they know what the plans for action are.
