RISE UP TO GET PAY 1023

GET BALLOT READY

UNISON has been campaigning for a decent pay rise for council and school workers in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. We called for a pay increase of inflation plus 2%. Based on the Treasury's annual forecast for RPI for 2023, this would amount to 12.7%. However, the local government employers have responded with an offer of a flat rate increase of $\mathfrak{L}1,925$. In a cost-of-living crisis this simply is not good enough.

As a result, UNISON is balloting members working in councils and schools to ask if you wish to take industrial action over pay. It's only by taking action that we will send a clear message to employers that you need a better pay rise.

Every single eligible member needs to vote in the upcoming ballot. We can only take lawful industrial action if at least 50% members return their ballot papers to us.
